



Parent Assessment Form

Please answer the questions below to the best of your knowledge. This form will provide a basis for my exam and allow me to focus on the specific symptoms your child displays. A thorough exam of all your child's symptoms will be conducted on the day of the consultation.

- 1) Has your child ever had a thumb or finger sucking habit?
- 2) Has your child ever had allergies or food sensitivities?
- 3) Do you notice that your child occasionally has his/her mouth open at rest?
- 4) Has your child ever had troubles with speech, or been in a speech therapy program?
- 5) Has anyone ever told you that your child may be tongue-tied?
- 6) Did your child have any difficulties feeding as an infant?
- 7) Has your child experienced any issues with digestion? (stomach aches, burping, gas, acid reflux, etc)
- 8) Do you notice that your child has a hyper-active gag reflex?
- 9) Does your child have difficulty swallowing pills?
- 10) Does it seem like your child is a messier eater than other kids? (chews with mouth open, drinks and chews at same time etc.)
- 11) Has your child experienced any breathing issues or difficulties? (chronic congestion, asthma, etc.)
- 12) Has your child had their tonsils removed, or have you been told the tonsils are enlarged?
- 13) Do you notice that your child tends to breathe through his/her mouth more often than their nose?

Generally, if any of these questions can be answered "yes", your child is likely to have some myofunctional concerns.
